#### **1. Introduction:**

The Spices Board is an autonomous body under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Govt. of India) with a mandate to promote the export of spices and spice products from India. Quality Evaluation Laboratory(QEL) of the Board at Kochi was established in 1990, to evaluate the quality of the spices produced in different producing centres across the country, to assess the quality and safety of spices and spice products exported from India, and to render analytical service to the stakeholders in spice sector, viz. exporters, traders, farmers, research organizations etc. Since then the Board has also established laboratories at Mumbai (Maharashtra) Guntur (Andhra Pradesh), Gummidipoondi(Chennai,Tamilnadu), Narela(New Delhi), Tuticorin(Tamilnadu) Kandla(Gujarat) and at Baruipur (Kolkata)

### 2. Scope of the tender:

The requirement of the instruments for Microbiological Testing in this tender is for QEL Kandla and Baruipur Kolkata, for analysis of Microbiological contaminant in spices and spice products. The scope of the tender is as follows:

(a) Supply of the Instruments for Microbiological Testing as per Annexure 1, in which specifications of the required Instruments for Microbiological Testing and estimated quantity of the instrument are given.

(b) The successful bidder should be able to make available the products with required specifications at all the locations of the Board's laboratories, on receipt of the purchase order. The addresses of these laboratories are given in Annexure -2.

(c)The quoted rate should include all charges including transportation, packing, insurance, taxes, etc as applicable.

(d) The Board reserves the right to place order for the required items either together or in part (staggered supply) depending on requirements in the laboratories.

(e)Customs Clearance : The customs clearance duty if any for imported instruments will be paid by Spices Board at actuals. The successful bidder has to arrange the customs clearance and delivery of the items at the Board's Laboratories as per purchase orders issued.

### **3. Eligibility Criteria and Technical Requirements**

The eligibility criteria and technical requirements for participating in the tender are given below. Supporting documents proving the eligibility criteria shall be uploaded while submitting e-tender

Tender shall be submitted by reputed manufactuers / suppliers of high quality of Instruments for Microbiological Testing including all required accessories, with the capability of nation-wide delivery.

The tenderer should primarily submit evidence of their capability to provide service in the areas detailed below. The documents as per the description below should be uploaded as a single PDF file, with apropriate section headings as per each of the requirement below, along with the e-tender:

- a) Proof of Experience: Experience of having supplied Instruments for Microbiological Testing for which the bidder is quoting in this tender, during the last three years.
- b) Authorization from OEM: If the bidder is supplying the Instruments for Microbiological Testing on behalf of a company, the authorized supplier certificate from the manufacturer for the quoted items should necessarily be included.
- c) Technical Compliance Statement: The technical requirements of the tender are included in Annexure 1 below. A technical compliance statement including each

point in the docment should be included in the PDF file. If any of the points in the technical compliance statment requires submission of document as proof, that also should be included in the PDF file.

Against each point in the technical specification, compliance must be marked as YES / NO

- d) Undertaking: A statement signed by the authorized signatory of the bidder, stating that (a) supply of the items can be undertaken at all the locations of the Board's laboratories mentioned in Annexure 2 of the tender document, and (b) the bidder agrees to all the terms and conditions of this Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) should be included in the PDF file.
- e) Any other requirement of proof or clarification, mentioned in any of the sections below, should be included in the PDF file.
- f) Any specific terms and conditions regarding the supply, shipment and delivery of the quoted items should be explicitly mentioned.
- g) PDF files uploaded with incomplete details with regard to eligibility criteria are liable to be rejected.

## 4. Price Bid:

a)The details are to be filled in as per Table 1 below in the online tender only (not to be included in the eligibility criteria PDF document) for the items quoted. Each of the rows in the table below will be available online in the e-tender, which has to be filled by the tenderer. The prices quoted should specify taxes, transportation and freight charges.

b)The price bid has to be subject to the following terms and conditions:

c)The prices once offered must remain fixed and must not be subject to escalation for any reason whatsoever within a period of 18 months from the date of the award of contract.

d)If a successful bidder (who has quoted lowerst price for an item as per Annexure 1) is not able to provide a product(s) at the quoted price at any point during 18 months after the award of the contract, then the contract with this bidder will be cancelled for that product(s) and will be awarded successively to the next lowest bidder(s) who meet the technical specifications for that product(s).

### **5. Submission of Bids:**

 a) Spices Board reserves the right to accept or reject any of bids / proposals submitted.

- b) At any time before the last date of submission of tender, Spices Board may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by potential bidders, amend the tender document.
- c) Any amendment shall be informed to the bidders by publishing in the Spices Board website and shall be binding on them. Spices Board may at its discretion extend the deadline for the submission of tender.
- d) The applicant is required to visit the Spices Board website / MSTCL website for any changes or amendments in the tender before submitting their tenders.
- e) Firms registered in India participating in the bid have to submit the bid through the e-procurement portal as outlined below in Appendix 1.

### 6. EMD Requirements

- a) Bidders should submit an EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) 2% of estimated value of the instrument along with the tender by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Secretary, Spices Board" payable at Kochi, from any nationalized bank. The EMD shall be valid for three months. Bank Guarantee will not be accepted towards EMD.
- b) The technical bid without EMD will be rejected unless specifically exempted by the Government from payment of EMD for which reasons and proof have to be enclosed.
- c) EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded (without any interest) within 45 days from the date of opening of tender.
- d) EMD amount of the Successful Bidder will be refunded (without any interest) within 30 days after acceptance of work order and submission of "contract performance guarantee".
- e) EMD will be forfeited if the vendor withdraws or amends its tender or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of its tender.
- f) EMD shall be submitted in sealed envelope, superscribing the words "Tender for the Procurement of Instruments for Microbiological Testing in Spices Board, Quality

### 7. Performance Security

The successful bidder has to submit a Performance Security for an amount of 20% of the order value in the form of a Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank. Performance security should be submitted within 21 days after release of purchase order and should be valid for 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations including warranty obligation, and it will be released after 60 days beyond warranty period.

Submission of Performance security for equipments exempted upto order value of Rs 1 lakh.

**8**. Five year comprehensive warranty shall include calibration of the equipment using traceable standards at least once in a year

**9.** Repair of the equipment should be attended within three working days ,failure will result in extension of the five year warranty period.

**10.** Comprehensive warranty shall include two preventive maintenance per year and any number of break down visits

**11.** Disputes and Jurisdiction: Any legal disputes arising out of any breach of contract pertaining to this tender shall be settled in the court of competent jurisdiction located within the city of Ernakulam, Kochi.

### 12. Other Terms and Conditions

- a) Delivery Schedule: Supply of the instrument should be fixed for supply within 30/45 days from the date of award of contract.
- b) Payment: No Advance payment will be made for items manufactured in India. For these instruments, payment shall be made only after satisfactory installation is agreed to wherever the installation is involved. For imported instrument, the payment will be arranged as per terms and conditions agreed between Spices Board and the tenderer during finalization of the purchase.
- c) Payment shall be released only after satisfactory training to the Laboratory staff.
- d) Warranty/Guarantee: The offer should clearly specify the terms of warranty as applicable including all the spares/accessories and consumables required for the smooth and continuous functioning of the equipment
- e) Risk Purchase Clause: In the event of failure of suply of the item within the stipulated delivery schedule, the Board reserves the right to purchase the item from other sources on total risk of the supplier under Risk Purchase Clause.
- f) Successful bidders shall accept the contract in writing within 10 days of date of award of contract.
- g) Tender received after the closing time for submission will not be considered.
- h) The tender must remain valid for at least 6 months from the date of opening of the tender. A tender valid for a shorter period will be rejected as non-responsive. On completion of validity period, unless the tenderer withraws his tender in writing, it

will be deemed to be valid until such time the tenderer formally (in writing) withdraws the tender.
