Spices Board invites application from the Children of Cardamom Estate Workers in Kerala/Tamil Nadu/Karnataka Region for availing assistance in the form of Educational Stipend under Plantation Welfare Scheme for pursuing post SSLC Education subject to the following eligibility criteria.

- 1) Children of workers and staff employed in Cardamom Estate registered/applied for registration are eligible for stipend provided Income should not exceed Rs.3000/- per month per parent.
- 2) The applicant should not be in receipt of any other grant, stipend or scholarship.
- 3) Only two children of a worker/staff member of the estate shall be eligible for stipend under this scheme.
- 4) The applicant's father/mother should have a minimum of 120 days work during the period from 1.4.2012 to 31.3.2013 in Cardamom Estate.
- 5) Eligibility criteria for this purpose is 50% marks in the SSLC/Plus Two/Degree Course

EDUCATIONAL STIPEND TO CHILDREN OF
CARDAMOM ESTATE WORKERS 2013-14

The Spices Board, in keeping with the provisions in Spices Board Act 1986, has been implementing schemes for the welfare of the Cardamom Estate Workers. The scheme for the grant of educational stipend to the children of cardamom plantation workers has been one among them.

Primary education is free in all the cardamom growing states. The purpose of the educational stipend scheme is to encourage education beyond the school level.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Eligibility

1. The Scheme shall be operated within the budgetary provision made for this purpose.
2. The children of workers and staff employed in Cardamom Estates Registered/applied for registration are eligible for stipend provided parent's income (total emoluments) do not exceed Rs.3000/- per month per parent. If a parent was unable to attend the work due to protracted illness a certificate from the estate owner that the worker was unable to work due to the above reason even though he was in the regular roll should be produced along with a Medical Certificate in respect of the Estate worker.
3. The applicant should not be in receipt of any other grant, stipend or scholarship.
This restriction shall not be applicable in the case of SC/ST/OBC.

If a recipient of the stipend happens to study in the same class for more than one year consequent to his/her inability to appear for the examination in the first year due to illness, such students are eligible for stipend during the second year also on production of satisfactory evidence.

4. Only two children of a worker/staff member of the estate shall be eligible for stipend under this scheme.
5. The applicant's father/mother should have a minimum 120 days' work during the period from 1-4-2012 to 31-3-2013 in a cardamom estate registered/ applied for registration.

Quantum of stipend

1. The scheme shall be applicable to students pursuing post-SSLC education. The post SSLC education to be covered under the scheme could be professional or non professional. The bias shall be towards technical education. The qualifying marks in SSLC/PDC/Degree course for this purpose shall be 50 per cent.
2. In the case of those pursuing Pre-Degree course/Degree course in Commerce & Arts, the stipend shall be Rs.400/- per annum.
3. For those pursuing Pre-Degree Course/Degree Course/PG Degree course in Science disciplines, Technical Courses including ITI, the Stipend shall be Rs.750/- per annum.
For professional Courses including Engineering/Medicine/M.C.A./M.Sc. (Computer)/ M.Sc (IT)/B.Sc.(Nursing) etc. the stipend shall be Rs.1500/- per annum.
Assistance shall be available for the duration of the course or three years whichever is shorter.
6. Stipend will be enable in institutions in the Indian Union affiliated or recognised by a University or Board of Secondary Education, or within the purview of Director of Public Instruction or some other appropriate public Body or Authority.

Application and Selection

7. Application forms for registration for grant of stipend can be had from the Secretary, Spices Board, Cochin-25 or from the offices of Assistant Directors/Field Officers of Spices Board on request.
8. The application form provides for a certificate from the estate in which his/her parents are working, which may be obtained and the application form may then be sent to the Head of the Educational Institution. After getting the necessary entries by the Head of Institution, the forms may be sent to the nearest Office of the Spices Board for onward transmission to the Head Office.
9. Selection of candidates for award of stipend will be made by the Board subject to availability of funds and the awardees will be informed through the Head of Institution. Board's decision in this regard shall be final.
10. Incomplete & incorrect applications will not be considered and no correspondence entertained.

Payment of Stipend

12. The Officer of the Board/Head of the Institution will disburse the stipend to the concerned students and acknowledgement from the recipient shall be obtained. The acquittance duly counter signed by the Head of the institution shall be forwarded to the Spices Board, Cochin-682 025.

General

13. Stipend may be withdrawn at any time or suspended for such period as the Board thinks fit if the awardee has, by reason of his/her own act or default failed to make satisfactory progress in his/her studies or has been found guilty of misconduct.
14. The Board reserves the right to make such additions or amendments to these Rules as it considers necessary at anytime.
