Sub: Import Ban on Indian Plant Products by Russia – Compliance with quality formalities – reg.

. . . .

The Government of Russia, Department of Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Surveillance has notified that w.e.f. 28th January, 2008 import of tea, coffee & spices [indicative list furnished below] will be allowed only through the Russian Ports at St. Petersburg, Leningrad and Kalingrad and the imported produce have to conform the phytosanitary requirements of the Russian Federation. The products are to be transported in packages, made without use of natural plant fibers and accompanied with the information about preventive disinfection of packages and containers made by the agencies, authorized by the Indian National Quarantine and Plant Protection Organization.

The exporters are, therefore, requested to strictly comply with the above requirements for clearing the consignments exported to Russia.
