Sub: Mandatory Sampling & Testing of export consignments of Spices & Spice products under the Quality Evaluation System of Spices Board-reg

Ref: 1) Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/913 of 30th May 2022.

2) Circular No: 05/2022-23 dated 27 May, 2022.

3) Circular No.24/2021 dated 02nd February 2022.

In line with the European Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/2246 dated 15th December 2021, Spices Board, vide circular cited under reference 3, had made it mandatory to have cleared Analytical Report and Official Certificate (Health Certificate) issued by the Board for Ethylene oxide (ETO), for export of notified spices to EU, intended to be used as food and/or feed.

In partial modification to the Circular, MRL of ETO in various Spice Mixes (masalas, curry paste, sauces, RTE, RTC etc.) is revised to the limit of Capsicum Annum i.e., **0.02 mg/kg** from the existing limit of 0.1 mg/kg, since most of the spice mixes will be having chilli as one of its ingredients. The new limit will be applicable irrespective of the percentage of chilli content in the product. The modified MRL list of ETO in various spices/spice products are given in Table 1.

Further, Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/913 of 30th May 2022 has withdrawn the requirement of Health Certificate for Aflatoxin for Nutmeg and Nutmeg products originating from India, for importing into EU. Also ETO check is only applicable for dried spices and spices in raw form are exempted as per the new regulation.

Correspondingly, exporters no longer require to avail Health Certificate for Aflatoxin from the Board for their Nutmeg and Nutmeg products consignments destined to EU. However mandatory testing for Aflatoxin in Nutmeg/Nutmeg products to EU & U.K shall remain in force until further notification in this regard.

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This circular, issued under the provisions of the Spices Board Act 1986 & Spices Board (Registration of Exporters) Regulations 1989, will take effect from **01/12/2022** and shall remain in force until further guidelines / instructions are prescribed by Spices Board, in this regard.
