Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Warranty

Bidder / OEM has to give an undertaking that after expiry of warranty period, it will provide AMC Service for next 2 years for the offered products at the rate not more than 3 % of contract price per annum. During the CMC period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months or as per user requirement. Cost of consumables shall not be included in CMC.Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during CMC period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend CMC period by double the downtime period.
