Sub: Compliance with Thailand's Pesticide Residue Standards for Export of Spices and Spice Products from India – Trade Advisory – reg.

This is to bring to the attention of all exporters of spices and spice products that the Thai Food and Drug Administration has reported instances of non-compliance in consignments of spices and spice products exported from India, primarily on account of exceedance of pesticide residue limits as per Thailand's regulations.

In this regard, an unofficial English translation of Thailand's standards/regulations for pesticide residues in food (including spices) has been made available on the Spices Board website and may be accessed at:

In view of the above, all exporters of spices and spice products are hereby advised to ensure strict compliance with Thailand's pesticide residue standards. Further, the exporters shall exercise due diligence and ensure that all consignments of spices and spice products exported from India to Thailand comply with the prescribed limits under Thailand's regulations.

This advisory is issued under the provisions of the Spices Board Act, 1986 and the Spices Board (Registration of Exporters) Regulations, 1989, as amended from time to time.
